#### **DEAR PARENTS!**

We are happy that you decided to enrol your child in our school. A change in environment is a great step to unknown and we will do our best to welcome your child. The only possible way to do it is with your active participation and mutual cooperation.

We would like to give you the basic information that will help you and your child adapt to the new situation and environment.



#### **ENROLMENT**

It takes place at office 29 (first floor) and it is taken care of by Mrs. Helena Piškur, head of school advisory service. To enrol your child, the following documents are needed:

- -parents' and child's identity card
- -certificate of permanent or temporary residence in Slovenia and child's personal registration number if the child already has it
- -photocopy of the last school report
- -authenticated translation of the last school report
- -medical certificate for the passed medical examination before entering the primary school



<u>Medical examination</u> is done in Kranj Health Centre by Mrs. Majda Cergolj M.D., specialist in school medicine.

<u>Enrolment certificate</u> is issued by the school in one month's time. (If it is by any reason needed before, the parents are given the enrolment information.)

Moving the child to another school is also taken care of by Mrs. Tamara Gorenc, head of school advisory service.

### SCHOOL SUPPLIES

#### School library

- Books can be borrowed at the school library via the book fund.
- Workbooks can be bought at the bookshop.
- 3. <u>Check</u> the school supplies your child already has and buy the missing ones.
- 4. Your child also needs slippers at school.

In case of <u>financial problems</u> please contact our social worker Mrs. Polonca Mayer.

### SCHOOL ALIMENTATION

It is possible to fill in the registration form for:

- -snack
- -lunch
- -afternoon snack (1st 5th class)



Alimentation cancellation is possible every day until 8:20 a.m. at the secretary's office.

### EXTRA SERVICES PROGRAMME

Parents are given the possibility to bring their child to school before class starts (between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.). It is meant for the pupils from  $1^{\rm st}$  to  $3^{\rm rd}$  class. For  $1^{\rm st}$  graders it is meant to last up to 7:50 a.m. and for the  $2^{\rm rd}$  and  $3^{\rm rd}$  graders it is meant to last up to 8:15 a.m.

There is also a possibility for the child to stay at school after class ends. This option is given to all pupils from  $1^{st}$  to  $5^{th}$  class. During that time the child can play in the classroom or in the playground and socialize with friends, do homework and eat lunch. Parents can also decide for the child to eat lunch at home and then come back to school to do homework.

For both forms of extra services programme there is an entry form that needs to be filled in.

## THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL



The child comes to school at 8:10 a.m. through the dressing room. The child needs to bring slippers and school supplies (a school bag, a pencil case and some notebooks). Then

the child waits in front of Mrs. Tamara Gorenc office (head of school advisory service).

### CHILD'S TIMETABLE

The class begins at  $\underline{7:30 \text{ a.m.}}$ , or at  $\underline{8:20}$   $\underline{a.m.}$ , or at  $\underline{9:10 \text{ a.m.}}$  - according to pupil's personal timetable.



- Pupils come to school 10 minutes before class starts.
- They enter the school through the dressing room where they change shoes to slippers.
- -They are not allowed to leave the classroom without teacher's permission.
- -If the child is ill or does not feel well, we contact you on the phone so that you can come and pick your child up.

IMPORTANT: As parents you need to be available on the phone in case of urgent information concerning your child.

# HELPING PUPILS TO EMBRACE THE SCHOOL LIFE AND SCHOOL WORK

Pupils are included to the so called **preparatory class** that starts in the last week of August.

Its purpose is for pupils **to learn Slovene** and to get familiar with the new school and broad environment

There is also extra class for individual school subjects and additional extra help to learn Slovene.

Pupils who stay at school after the end of the class (extra services programme) are also given additional help with learning.

#### WORKING WITH PARENTS

Parents should regularly take interest in child's school work.

CONTACT HOURS (conversation about your child)



- 1. Every teacher has weekly morning contact hours according to his / her timetable.
- 2. Contact hours also take place monthly (every first Tuesday from 18:00 to 19:00).
- 3. It is also possible to have individual contact hours but they need to be pre-arranged with every teacher.
- 4. Contact hours with Mrs. Helena Piškur, head of school advisory service, also need to be **pre-arranged**.

The purpose of contact hours is getting the important information. Parents are also given the invitation.



Help with translation: to contact hours you can also bring a person you trust so that he/she will help you with the language.

Pupils and parents are kindly invited to actively participate in the activities organized in school. It is the only way to make the period of adaptation not only shorter but also more effective.
